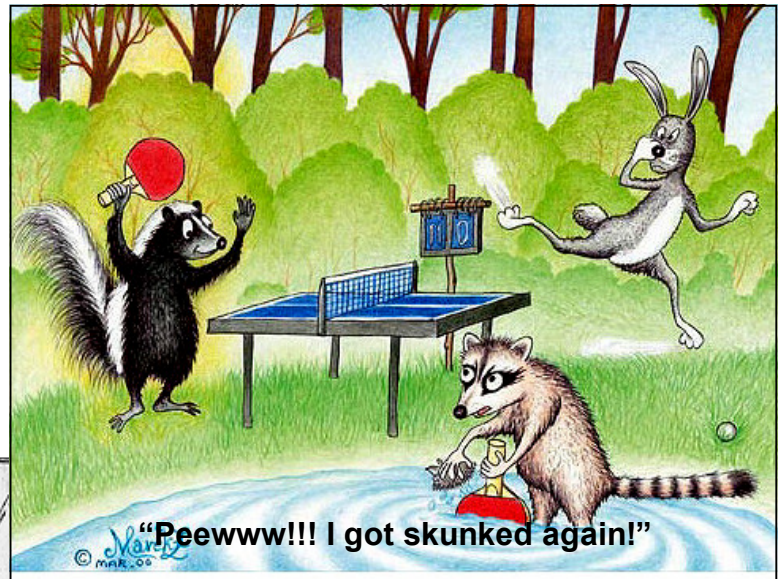
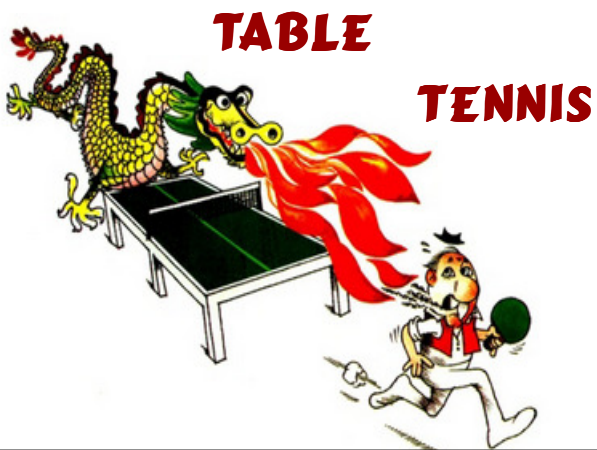
What would YOU do? What Lancelot chose is below.

*The moral is.....If you don't let a woman have her own way....**Things are going to get ugly.***

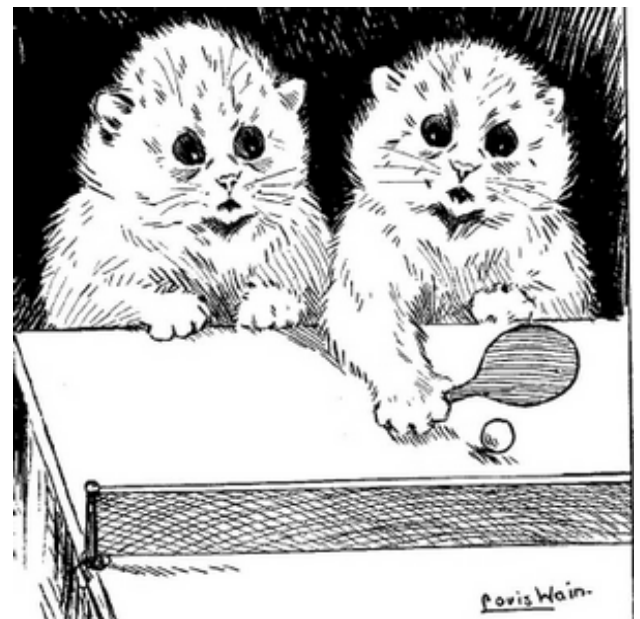
