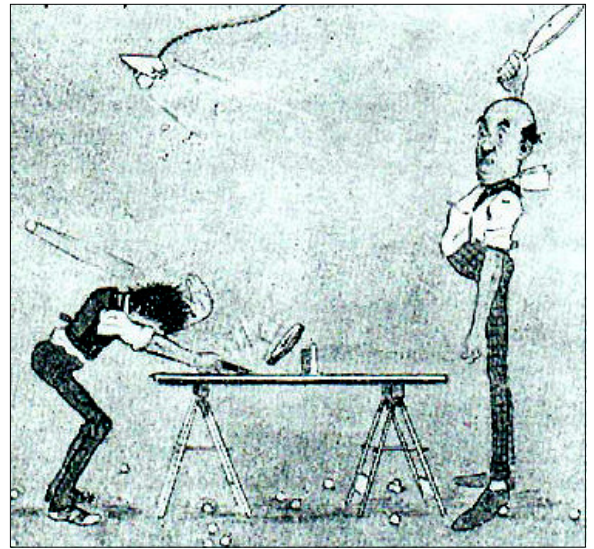

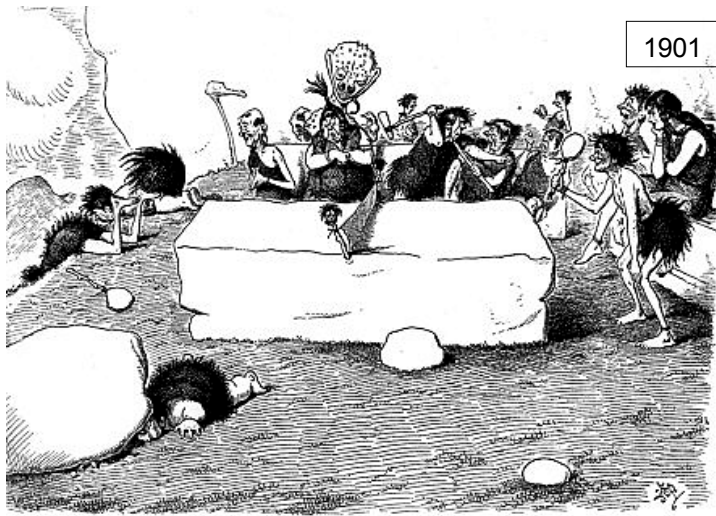

Now, isn't that a sweet story?'



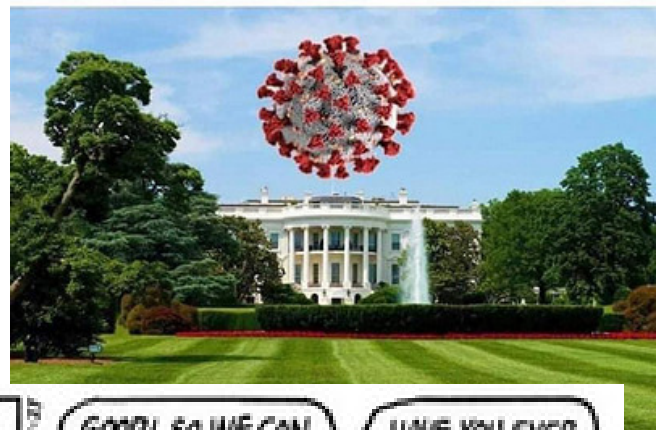

As a senior citizen, I do not get flustered often, but this time it took me a while to get my pants back on.

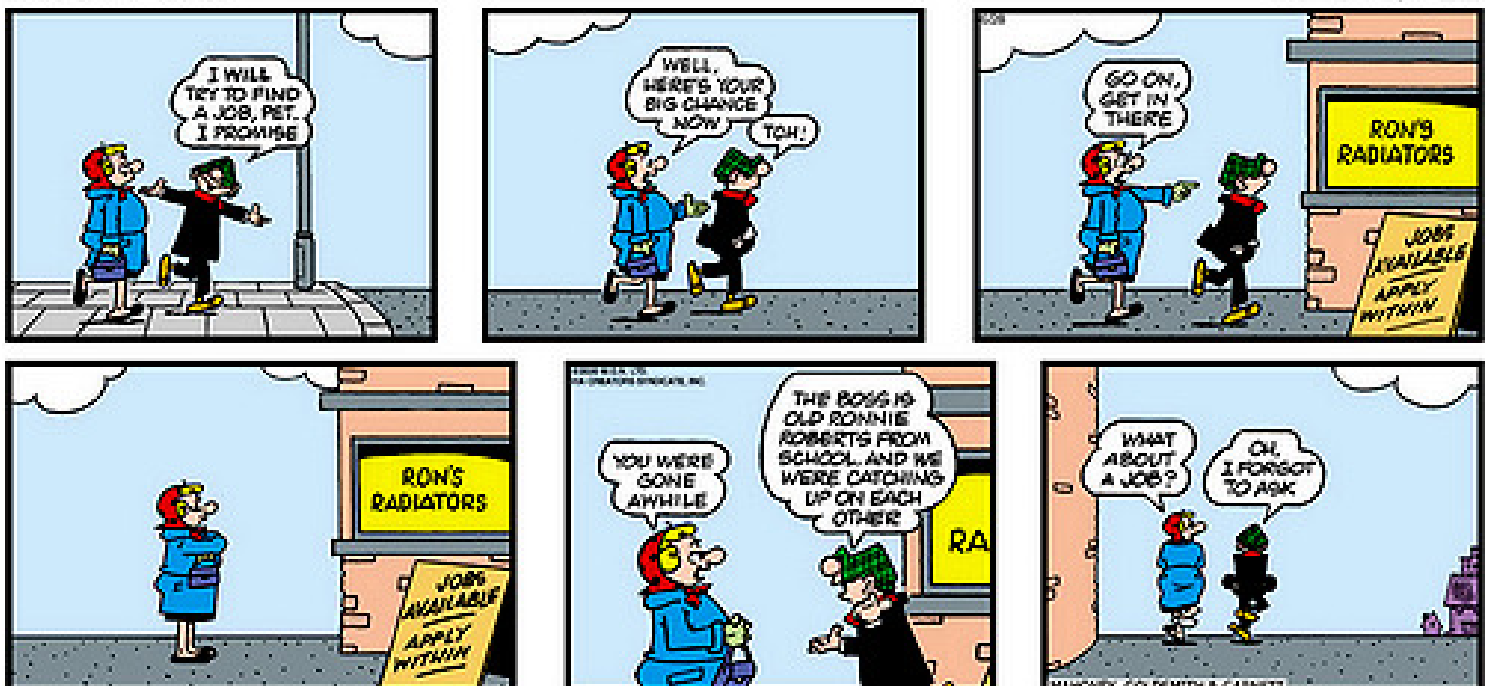
I've been asked to shop elsewhere in the future.

2. Law of Gravity

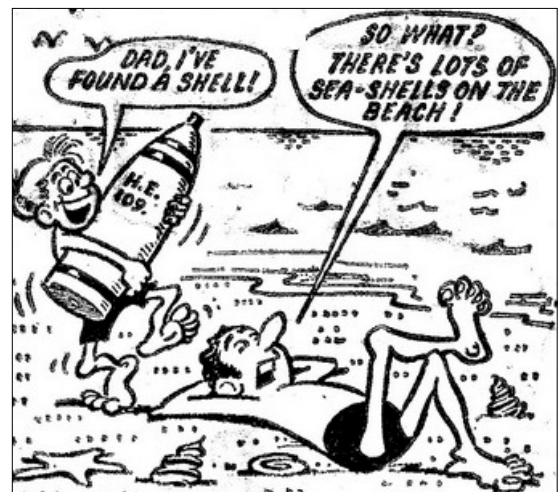
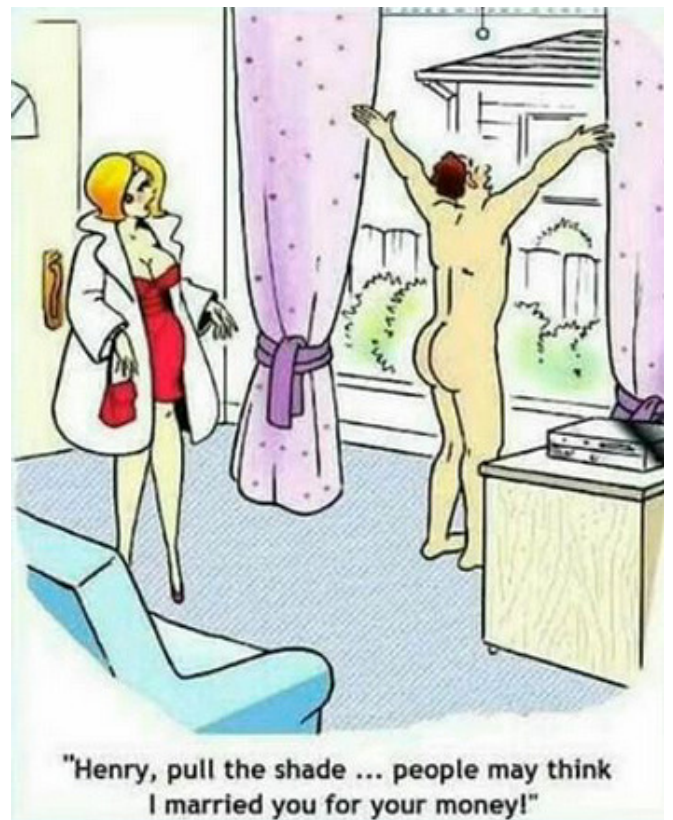

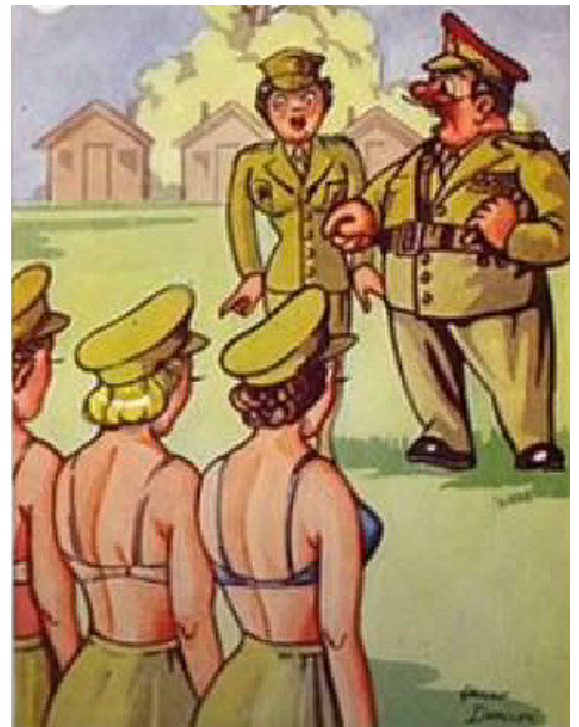
