Do you use an ink jet colour printer and periodically buy cartridges from local stores? Seems to me they are a rip off!


There are a number of cheaper online sellers. I use:

The Serve

The service rule is designed to create a level playing field for the participants but still allowing some flexibility to enable some variant to the delivered serve.



The **SERVICE rule** states:

- 2.6.1 Service shall start with the ball resting freely on the open palm of the server's stationary free hand.
- 2.6.2 The server shall <u>then project the ball near vertically upwards</u>, without imparting spin, so that it rises <u>at least</u> **16cm** after leaving the palm of the free hand and then falls without touching anything before being struck.
- 2.6.3 <u>As the ball is falling</u> the server shall strike it so that it touches first his or her court and then touches directly the receiver's court; in doubles, the ball shall touch successively the right half court of server and receiver.
- 2.6.4 From the start of service until it is struck, the ball shall be <u>above the level</u> <u>of the playing surface and behind the</u> <u>server's end line</u>, and it <u>shall not be hidden</u> from the receiver by the server or his or her doubles partner or by anything they wear or carry.



Some notes:

- The rules are designed to give the recipient a view of the ball about to be played and chance for them to return satisfactorily. It also must be able to be seen by any umpire.
- Servers must not place ball on open hand, drop the hand away and immediately hit the ball as though scrapping
 the ball from the hand.
- Any variant to the "Service Rule" above is an attempt to give the server a distinct advantage by surprise and could be considered a form of cheating although not very subtle!!
- In a social club like ours serving correctly will in most cases start off a game in a good manner enabling everyone to commence with a reasonable rally.
- In more serious play of course server players are free when hitting the ball to apply any of the nasties like spin as they strike the ball.




